The UNDC was created in 1979 to build and sell new single-family homes within Community Development Areas, where existing homes are rehabilitated with city assistance along with improvements to streets, sidewalks and utilities. Today, the UNDC continues to build & sell homes in the traditional areas as well as acquiring land to build new homes in scattered areas throughout the city, including small allotments.

Since 1979 the UNDC has built over 385 new homes.
